

Frances Wall

Frances Wall is Professor of Applied Mineralogy at Camborne School of Mines, University of Exeter (United Kingdom), former head of Camborne School of Mines from 2008 to 2014, and currently serving as President of the Mineralogical Society of Great Britain and Ireland. After graduating with a degree in geochemistry from Queen Mary College London, Frances Wall worked at the Natural History Museum in London, specialising in carbonatites and alkaline rocks, including economic deposits of rare earths and niobium, and gaining a PhD from the University of London. Frances Wall moved to Camborne School of Mines in 2007 and with the privilege of the multidisciplinary overview of the mining industry that Camborne School of Mines provides, developed an interest in responsible mining.
