Professor Sir Michael Brady is currently a member of the Department of Oncology at the University of Oxford, having recently retired as Professorship in Information Engineering (1985-2010). Mike is the author of over 600 articles and 26 patents in computer vision, robotics, medical image analysis, and artificial intelligence, and the author or editor of 10 books, and was the founding Editor of the International Journal of Robotics Research (1981-2000). He has been elected a Fellow of the Royal Society, Fellow of the Royal Academy of Engineering, Honorary Fellow of the Institution of Engineering and Technology and Fellow of the Academy of Medical Sciences. He has 8 honorary doctorates. As well, Mike has a continuing strong commitment to commercialisation of science and has started 6 successful companies and is/has been a Director of 7 others. Mike was awarded the Whittle Medal, the UK's leading award for engineering innovation.
