## Short bio

Giuseppe Marcocci is Associate Professor of Early Modern History at the University of Viterbo and Adjunct Professor of World History at the University of Florence. He taught courses at the Scuola Normale Superiore, the University of Lisbon and the École des Hautes Études en Sciences Sociales. His main field of interest is the history of the early modern Iberian empires in a global perspective. Currently, he is the principal investigator of the three-year research project “Translating Worlds: Towards a Global History of Italian Culture, 1450-1914” (2017-2020), funded by the Italian Ministry for the Education, University and Research.
