Franck Lecocq is the CIRED director and professor of economics at AgroParisTech (the Paris Institute of Technology for Life, Food and Environmental Sciences).

Franck Lecocq has published extensively on the economics of climate change, and his current research focuses on the role of infrastructure in the mitigation of climate change policies, the relationship between climate change and sustainable development, the economy of the adaptation to climate change and the relationship forest / carbon.

Franck Lecocq was previously deputy director of forestry laboratory (INRA / AgroParisTech) in Nancy, France, and economist for Economic Development Group of the World Bank. He holds a PhD in economics from AgroParisTech.

He is a member of the Business Council for Sustainable Development of the French Ministry of Environment, Energy and Sustainable Development, and a lead author of the fourth and fifth IPCC assessment reports.
