BIOSKETCH OF ALLAN YOUNG

Allan Young is a social anthropologist and a professor in the Departments of Social Studies of Medicine, Psychiatry, and Anthropology at McGill University. His earliest ethnographic research was conducted in Ethiopia and Nepal. His subsequent fieldwork was in the United States and focused on the diagnosis and treatment of traumatized veterans of the Vietnam War. For the past two decades, his work has concentrated on the epistemology of psychiatric science and the origins of the social brain.
