François Salanié is a Research Director at the French Institute for Agronomic Research (INRA) and an economist at the Toulouse School of Economics (TSE). He works on market failures that are related to asymmetries in the distribution of information, and the practical implications for financial markets, insurance, and regulation (water, pollution, and more generally the management of environment). His preferred methodological tools include Game Theory, Contract Theory, and Risk Theory. François Salanié graduated from ENSAE (a French school for economics and statistics) and got his PhD at Université Toulouse 1 Capitole. He works in Toulouse, where he has been Director of the *Laboratoire d'Économie des ressources naturelles* (LERNA).
