In my role as Director of Uppsala Forum, a multidisciplinary collaboration at Uppsala University bringing together the Faculties of Arts, Languages, Law and Social sciences, I am responsible for the internationalization of research, and for the organization of a number of events, such as joint seminars, workshops, international conferences, round table discussions and graduate and postgraduate courses.
