Le colloque est en anglais avec traduction simultanée.

Toutes et tous sont les bienvenus.

Le contrôle des frontières est devenu, dans de nombreux pays, un enjeu politique majeur posant des questions morales quant au traitement fait aux réfugiés et aux migrants. Une dimension rarement étudiée de ce phénomène concerne les discriminations qui s'opèrent sur ces frontières en fonction de l'origine des exilés, de leur apparence, de leur religion. Le colloque *Racial Borders* entend explorer de manière critique ce qu'on peut appeler la « racialisation des frontières » dans plusieurs contextes nationaux sur quatre continents. La confrontation de ces configurations différentes conduit à une réflexion plus large sur les formes d'inégalités que génèrent les frontières.

The control of borders has become in many countries a major political issue posing moral questions regarding the treatment of refugees and migrants. A rarely examined aspect of this phenomenon concerns the discriminations at the border according to the origin, appearance and religion of these refugees and migrants. The conference *Racial Borders* will critically explore what can be designated as the “racialization of borders” in various national contexts on four continents. The confrontation of these different configurations will lead to a broader reflection on the forms of inequality generated by borders.
